Enjoy out-of-town facilities right in the heart of the action

Treeline Urban Resort, Siem Reap, Cambodia

This 48-room riverside stay takes its inspiration from “the interplay of nature and civilisation” embodied by the nearby Angkor Wat. That would explain why it’s possible to sit at the bay window of your sleek, stone- and wood-accented room, surrounded by

lush foliage, and still be just a stone’s throw from the restaurant and nightlife scenes. You can also soak in the infinity pool under a leafy canopy, survey the hotel’s growing art collection and enjoy a traditional Southeast Asian spa treatment at Suri Spa.

Get there: Fly to Siem Reap on SilkAir and take a 20-minute taxi ride. treelinehotels.com

The Pushang, Xiamen, China

Though located in the bustling Huli District, this newly-opened hotel nevertheless offers stunning views of the marina and serene Wuyuan Bay. Take a break from the heat of southern China in the 56m outdoor pool, surrounded by sofa beds and umbrellas, and don’t miss the updated Chinese bath house experience at UR Spa, offering traditionally inspired therapies.

Get there: Fly to Xiamen on SilkAir. The hotel is 7.5km from the airport. thepushang.com



Movenpick Hotel Mactan Island, Cebu, Philippines

With a private beach dotted with white loungers, this waterfront property is a respite from downtown Cebu. Start your day with a snorkelling or watersports adventure arranged by the hotel, or dive into the free-form swimming pool. After a quick nap in your suite, head to their Ibiza Beach Club for tapas, grilled dishes and drinks before hitting the dance floor – there are resident DJs, themed shows and even live bands.

Get there: Fly to Cebu on SilkAir. The property is 25 minutes from the airport. movenpick.com
