Treeline Gallery aims to support young and emerging contemporary artists and build an inspirational platform that cultivates a deep appreciation for the arts. Our long-term vision is to create the Treeline Art Foundation and launch an artist in residence program that would host artists from across Southeast Asia.

1. About Treeline Artist Grants (TAG)

For its first year, TAG will support a maximum of 5 grants for **5 Cambodian artists**. Each artist may request **up to USD 2,000**, depending on their proposal's scope. The selected artists will be required to work closely with the Treeline Gallery Curator and to create **at least 3 art pieces**. They will then take part in a **group exhibition** which will be held from August 1st to November 2020 at Treeline Gallery*.

The selection committee is composed of Hok Kang, Urbanland Founder and Managing Director, and Meta Moeng, Treeline Gallery Curator.

2. <u>Guidelines and Eligibility Requirements</u>

Treeline Gallery invites all the Cambodian artists who want to create new original artworks and experiment their practice to apply.

The application must include:

- An updated Curriculum Vitae
- Your Artist statement and brief description of your current artistic practice
- Your portfolio of the recent projects / works (max.10 MB total)
- A brief presentation of your project including its intended objectives
- The requested budget with a short explanation
